Important information.

- Please note that mobile phones are not permitted to be used at pre-school, please do not use them when you drop off or pick up from the setting as this is a safeguarding concern.

Lunchtime Please can you put a small plate in your child's lunch box and please try to keep your child's lunch as healthy as possible. We do not allow sweets or solid chocolate bars in their lunch boxes. Lunch boxes are kept in the fridge during the morning to ensure they remain fresh until lunchtime.

We also have some children with severe food allergies attending pre school at the moment so we cannot allow any children to have eggs or nuts in their lunchboxes at the moment. Thank you for your cooperation with this.
